## New Policy on Web Posting for AERA Authors

In June 2003, AERA Council passed a resolution granting authors permission to post articles published in AERA journals on their personal websites or in an area that is designated to them on an institution's website. This policy will be effective until AERA otherwise provides electronic reprint access to journal articles.

To implement this policy, AERA requests that interested authors complete the Website Permission Form. This form, duly signed and authorized by AERA, allows authors to post AERA journal articles with the appropriate citation and authentication of the original work.
