Council of Early Career Physicians Call for Nominations

The American College of Physicians (ACP) strives to represent the diversity within Internal Medicine on ACP's councils, committees, and boards.

The CECP is responsible for responding to requests from the Board of Regents, committees, and staff for review of programs, products, and services, and advising the Board of Regents on:

- x Enhancing professional development for early career physicians
- x Fostering their involvement in College activities
- x Increasing the value of ACP membership for early career physicians
- x Strengthening chapter level councils and activities
- x Aligning council activities with the [College Strategic Priorities](#)

To be eligible to run for a seat on the CECP you must be:

- x A Member or Fellow of the College in good standing who is within 16 years of medical school graduation and who is no longer in training.

To be an effective council member you must commit to:

- x Serving a three-year term beginning during ACP Internal Medicine Meeting 2025, being held in New Orleans, LA from April 30 to May 5.
- x Participating in Internal Medicine Meeting during your term including attendance at CECP meetings and facilitation of early career physician activities, as appropriate, during the meeting.
- x Traveling to Philadelphia once each year, as appropriate,

How to Apply:

To be considered for a seat on the Council of Early Career Physicians, please prepare or request the following materials to be submitted by November 1, 2022 the [CECP nominations form](#).

- x Curriculum Vitae (*please highlight ACP/leadership activities*)
- x One-page nominating letter written by the candidate that answers the question:

What role can the Council of Early Career Physicians play in creating an environment within the College in which ACP members who are in the early career stage are more likely to actively participate at both the national and chapter level, and if elected to the CECP, what do you envision doing to assist in achieving these goals?

- x Two letters of support. One letter of support **MUST** be from your current ACP Chapter Governor. In special circumstances, a letter from a former governor or governor from another state may be appropriate. Approval for requests to obtain a letter from a former or current Governor other than the applicant's current Chapter Governor is granted at the discretion of the Chair.

application materials from the Council's Application Review Panel prior to the application deadline of November 1 must attach their draft application materials they wish to be reviewed via email to acpgovernance@acponline.org later than October 15th. Requests for panel review will not be accepted after October 15th.

The council will conduct elections in November/December, considering all aspects of diversity, each candidate's leadership/work experience, ACP involvement and potential contributions to the council.
